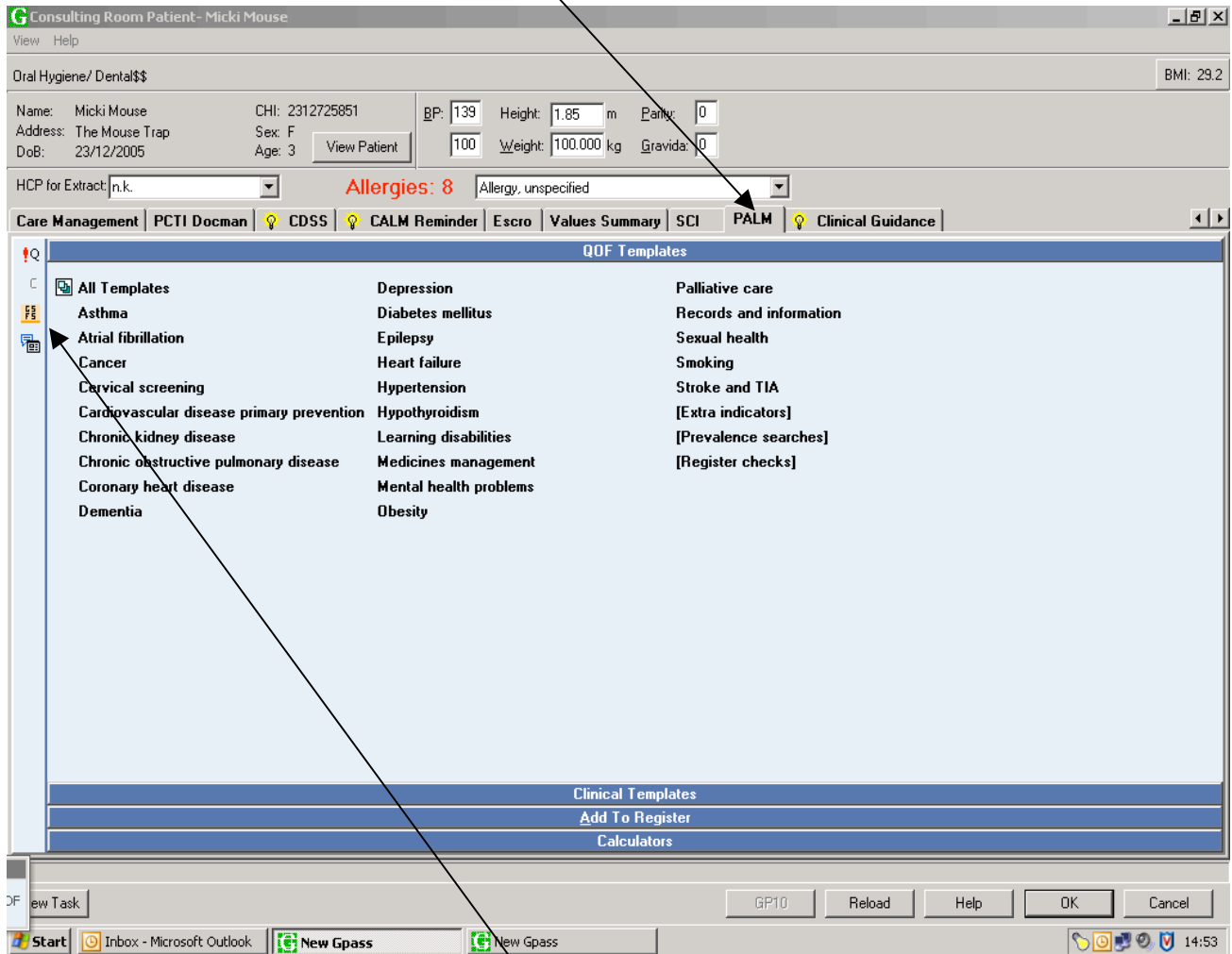


1: Click on the PALM tab in gpass :
